

At Myponga Primary School it is expected that all students will wear approved school clothing every day.

- ◆ Students not wearing dress code will not be permitted to attend excursions.
- ◆ **Swap a Top** ... We have a swap a top system in place to support families of students who have not been able to wear the required Dress Code to School on any one day. Students are offered a clean school top to wear in exchange for their own. At the end of the day, students return the top and are given their own back. There are similar arrangements for shorts/pants.
- ◆ Class teachers will write a note in the diary of any student who is not in approved School Dress Code so that parents are informed and can support their children in meeting this requirement.
- ◆ Mudlark Netball and Football clothing **is not permitted** to be worn as acceptable school attire.
- ◆ Drawstrings and cords are to be removed from items such as hats and hoodies.

## WHAT TO WEAR AT MYPONGA PRIMARY SCHOOL

Items approved by Governing Council

### GIRLS

- DRESS:** Green and white checked or Myponga school dress
- SHIRTS:** Polo – bottle green or gold
- SHORTS:** Black or bottle green (Plain – no logos)  
Shorts need to be mid or knee length.
- PANTS OR SKIRTS:** Black or bottle green
- TOPS:** Plain bottle green or bottle green with school logo-round-necked, hooded or polar fleece all available. Year 7s may wear the commemorative top. Bottle green and black waterproof jackets are suitable. Students need to remove waterproof jackets (of any colour) before entering the classroom.
- SKIVVIES:** Bottle green or gold
- HAT or BEANIE:** Must be approved sun-safe – legionnaire, wide-brimmed or bucket. Bucket & wide-brimmed are available for purchase at the front office. Beanies may be bottle green or black.
- FOOTWEAR:** Appropriate footwear to suit being active. **(No thongs)**. Gumboots may be used for outside play during periods of wet weather.
- JEWELLERY:** Sleepers and small studs only in ears allowed  
No eyebrows rings or face jewellery for safety reasons  
Limit bangles/bracelets/necklaces to those necessary (eg Medic-Alert).

### BOYS

- SHORTS:** Black or bottle green (Plain – no logos)  
Shorts need to be mid or knee length.
- SHIRTS:** Polo – bottle green or gold.
